### **NFHS Coach Education Program**

The NFHS Coach Education Committee met September 30-October 1 in Indianapolis to make recommendations to the NFHS Board of Directors concerning the program.

"Fundamentals of Coaching Soccer" was launched on September 22. This course, developed by the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) for the NFHS, provides coaches essential soccer coaching techniques and methods and shares practical resources for increasing student participation through effective feedback and stress reduction.

"Fundamentals of Coaching Wrestling," developed for the NFHS by the National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA), will be available in November. All sport-specific fundamentals courses can be accessed at www.nfhslearn.com.

The NFHS will launch its first single-focused learning module in December entitled, "Effectively Engaging with Parents." This 1-2 hour online module provides teacher/coaches with information and strategies to enhance their relationships with parents as well as to improve their communications skills. Please promote these courses and modules to your member schools as they will help improve the skills of individuals who work most closely with our students.

### **Football**

All proposals for football rules changes are due in the NFHS office by November 1. The forms were sent electronically in July. If you need a replacement copy, please contact Kim Adams or Bob Colgate at our office. The NFHS Football Rules Committee is asking all state associations to submit game statistics via the NFHS Web site. This is the eighth year football statistics have been compiled through the Web site, which has made the submission and compilation more efficient. Instructions will be sent later this month and the final day for submission is December 19. The NFHS Football Rules Committee uses this information to assist its review of rules proposals for the upcoming season.

## **Basketball**

The NFHS Basketball Rules Interpreters Meeting was held September 25 in Indianapolis. A bonus session was also held the previous evening to discuss important basketball issues. Twenty-seven states were represented by 44 meeting attendees. Henry Zaborniak, Ohio High School Athletic Association assistant commissioner; Darrin Cook, District of Columbia Interscholastic Athletic Association officials' coordinator/rules committee member; and Jim Robinson, Minnesota State High School League basketball rules interpreter, made a presentation to the group entitled "Video Replay – Practical and Philosophical Considerations." Nate Hampton of the Michigan High School Athletic Association and chairman of the rules committee, also helped present the 2008-09 rules changes and points of emphasis. Thanks to Hank, Darrin, Jim and Nate for outstanding presentations.
